Rotary Foundation Annual Giving Officer Monica Sullivan, right, visited the Rotary Club of Tupelo recently and reported that this year's contributions to annual giving were down by 16 percent, partially due to the contributions to the Gates Polio Challenge. The recession has also affected giving but investment earnings are returning and so far nothing has had to be liquidated to meet current expenditures. TRF is doing all it can to cut costs such as having committee meetings via webinar. Gates Polio Challenge contributions total \$105 million of the \$200 million needed by June 30, 2012.
