**Ian Banner**

*Facilities Planning Director, University of Mississippi*

Ian Banner is the director of Facilities Planning at The University of Mississippi, a position he's held since 2006. He came to UM as university architect in 2005. He is a member of the American Institute of Architects, and has a passion for low-energy architecture.

Prior to joining the Ole Miss staff, Banner was an architect in private practice with Shafer/Banner Architects from 1987 – 2004 with offices in Starkville, Mississippi and Huntsville, Ala., and taught at the

School of Architecture at Mississippi State University from 1987 to 1994. He was tenured in 1994.

Banner was born in Lutterworth, England, and earned a Master of Philosophy in Low-Energy Architecture from University of Cambridge.

He is a member of Darwin College, Cambridge, and a former member of the Royal Institute of British Architects. He stayed registered as an architect in the United Kingdom for twenty years.
