*New Expectations for Women in Mississippi and fellow Rotarian*

Rubye Del Harden is organizer and president of RESULTS, Inc., a consulting firm that works in the deep south to facilitate community and youth leadership programs. Rubye Del is a charter member and past president of NEWMS - New Expectations for Women in Mississippi. She is the developer and facilitator of the highly acclaimed Success Skills Leadership Program for Women which is sponsored by NEWMS, an affiliate of CREATE.

She is currently working with The Women's Center for Entrepreneurship to develop the

SMART management system. This new program, which will be launched in 2009, will enable owners/managers of small businesses to receive the management support and training which will enable them to survive and thrive in tough economic times. Owner/managers of small businesses will be eligible to participate in this program regardless of gender.

In addition to Results, Inc. Harden owns and operates SprintPrint, SNAP, The Dance Studio, Recovery Superstore and The Red Bay News.

**Polio fight gets boost from Gates, RI**

Rotary International's partnership for polio eradication with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation has increased its contribution to \$555 million.

The Rotary Foundation received a \$255 million Gates Foundation grant in January, for which Rotary will raise \$100 million in matching funds. In November 2007, RI received a \$100 million Gates Foundation grant, which Rotary committed to

match by raising \$100 million.

The two challenge grants now total \$355 million. Rotary has committed to raising a combined total of \$200 million in matching funds by June 30, 2012. This matching effort is called "Rotary's US\$200 Million Challenge."

Rotary will spend the grant in direct support of immunization activities carried out by the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, spearheaded by RI and its partners.
