Dave Carney serves as Supervisory Park Ranger (Interpretation) for the Natchez Trace Parkway. He has been a Park Ranger with the National Park Service for more than 18 years. He has been the District Interpretive Supervisor at the Natchez Trace Parkway for two years.

Prior to working at the Natchez Trace Parkway, Carney worked at the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Tuskegee Institute National Historic Site, and Cape Lookout

National Seashore.

He has degrees in Natural Resources and Recreation, Forestry, and Agriculture.

There are now 391 National Park Sights throughout the United States.

The National Park Service will be 100 years old in 2016. Every National Park Site in the Nation will be focused on improving visitor services between now and 2016 with the goal of helping the American public to grow closer to its National Parks.
