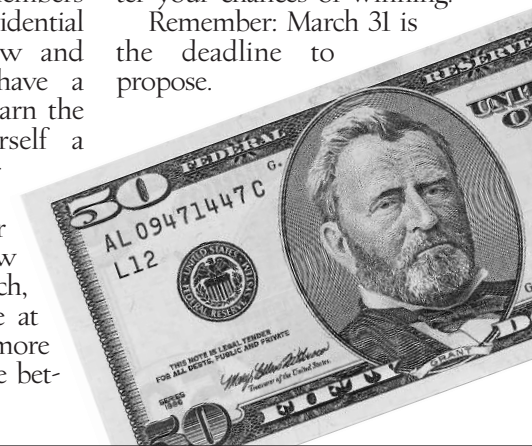
Propose a new member, get a chance at a \$50 gift certificate
