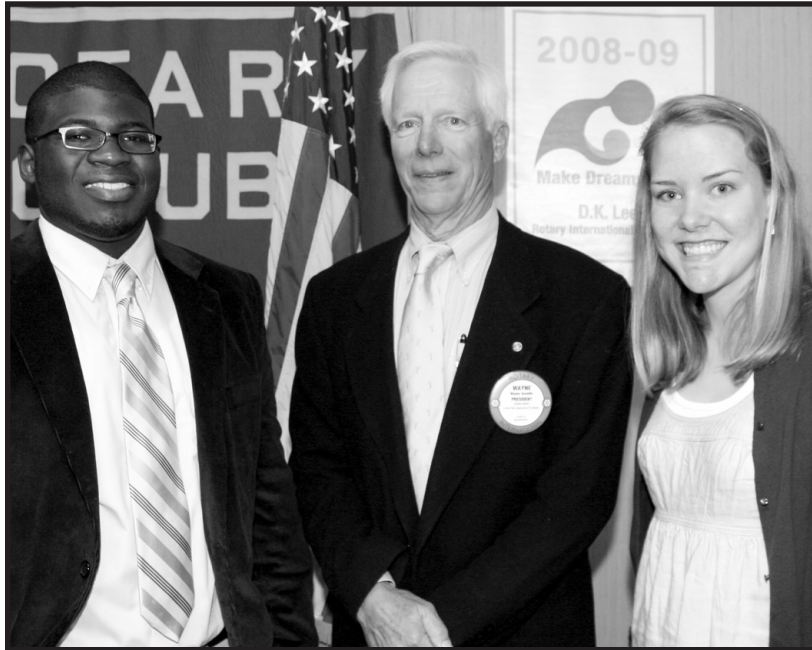

Callens began his professional career at Mississippi State Hospital where he was an Associate Psychologist. From there he went to the Department of Mental Health as a Program Planner/Evaluator where he was responsible for the facilitation of many statewide mental health programs. He later served as the Assistant
