Executive Director, Mississippi Heritage Trust

David Preziosi is executive director of the Mississippi Heritage Trust. A native of New Jersey, he finished high school in Plano, Texas, and earned a Bachelor of Environmental Design and a Master of Urban Planning with a Historic Preservation Certificate from Texas A&M University. He has been with the Trust since August 2002.

Prior to his work with the Trust, Preziosi served as city planner for the City of Natchez from 1998 to 2002. He was the Assistant City Planner/Historic Preservation Officer there from 1996 until his promotion in 1998.
