Athletics Director, Mississippi State University

Greg Byrne was named Mississippi State University's 15th Director of Athletics on February 21. He is the youngest current athletics administrator in the Southeastern Conference, and the youngest to lead an athletic program at the NCAA Division I-A level. In his career, he has been directly involved in raising more

than \$120 million in gifts.

Prior to being selected as MSU's new AD, Byrne was associate athletic director for external affairs at MSU. He held a similar position in Kentucky.

A native of Idaho, he earned a bachelor's degree from Arizona State. He is married and has two sons.
