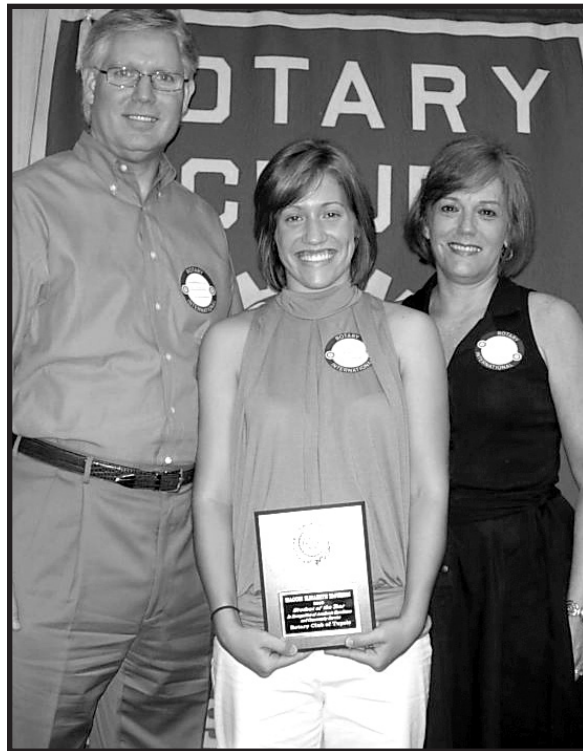

*Historic preservation tax incentives, on victorian architecture*

Todd Sanders is Tax Incentives Coordinator with the Mississippi Department of Archives and History, a position he's held since October 1, 2008.
